INTERMEDIATE RYEGRASS

For overseeding dormant warm season golf, sports fields, commercial and home turf areas

TranSport intermediate ryegrass was developed as a turf type ryegrass. TranSport has improved performance in dormant overseeding of lawn areas. Its best uses include overseeding suitable warm season grasses during the winter months.

Golf course fairways and sports fields are excellent use areas for this seed. Studies done recently at Mississippi State University show that Transport competes well in the emerging category of turf type annual or intermediate ryegrasses (see tables on pg. 2). Color, texture and turf quality are nearer to perennial ryegrass. Mowing quality is vastly improved with much less clippings versus common or Gulf annual ryegrass.

Budget conscious turf managers appreciate the fact that Transport can be used alone or in mixtures with perennial ryegrass. Transport is easier to transition back to warm season grasses in later spring than most perennial ryegrass varieties.
